# **The Star Room**

The Star Room™ is built as a sanctuary for the senses, using top-quality building components to create a sensory-neutral environment. It's therapeutic, eliminates sensory over-stimulation and provides the students with a calming, comforting and safe environment to regain their footing.

It's the first of its kind to address the entire environment – From a specifically designed paint palette of soothing colors to the non-flickering fiber-optic ceiling lights to hospital grade air filtration to recording studio grade soundproofing.

The design is based on consultation with autism medical experts and 45 years of research with treating sensory processing conditions. Upon completion, a thorough training of faculty and staff is implemented on proper usage of the room.

While created for children with autism, students with other sensory related issues, such as attention deficit/ hyperactivity disorder, that present challenges related to sensory processing and overstimulation, have benefited greatly from the room. These disorders can produce high levels of anxiety and stress, which can interrupt learning and lead to disruptive behavior.

A student experiencing such feelings can check into the supervised Star Room, choose an appropriate tool or technique to help "de-escalate," spend some time winding down, then return to the classroom ready to learn.

This purposeful sensory space isn't used as a means of discipline or reward, but solely to provide an appropriate, calming environment for students who need to de-escalate.

This one room helps students with autism do all the stuff kids should be able to do at school. Children with autism in every school system could benefit from a Star Room, and it's our vision to build them one.

# **How it Helps**

The Star Room has proven to be "an incredible, incredible success," says Mark Parent, special education director for Plain Local Schools (Canton, Ohio) 6,000-student district.

Mark said The Star Room's success is not based just in terms of its impact on the students who use it, but by the program's effect on teachers, caretakers and other students. He said these outcomes have been achieved:

Improved time on task. Students deescalate and return to classrooms able to access learning to a much higher degree

Reduction in stress for teachers, caretakers and classmates

Reduction in students' "acting out" through disruptive behavior such as hitting, biting and outbursts

Reduction in trips to the principal, early dismissal from school, bullying and name-calling by classmates

Increase in parents' comfort level and confidence that their child has a better chance to be successfully assimilated into school

Increase of classmates' understanding that "episodes" are only temporary and behaviors don't define people

# **More Than A Room**

To build communities of caring, we see a need to teach and promote empathy. Most programs for children with special needs place the emphasis on modifying the child's behavior. We know that autism is not a behavioral disorder, so the Love Andrew team with the help of Oakwood Middle School is putting together a new group program designed to help typical kids understand and be friends with someone with special needs.

Since the school day is so structured, the kids don't have time to develop deeper friendships – we want to help them move past the hellos and high-fives. The pilot group consists of seven boys, chosen because they display good character, empathy, and kindness. In order to give the boys an idea of what things are like for Andrew, a special demonstration was set up to illustrate what being overwhelmed by sensory input is like. The boys were asked to complete a trigonometry test, hard enough by itself, but with the addition of strobe lights and constant sounds for competing phone ringtones. No one was able to concentrate and finish the quiz.

Everyone has things they're good at and things that are challenging for them. What this exercise showed the boys was that people with autism have to do their challenging activity 24/7. Without a place like the Star Room, there's no way for them to regroup to put their best effort forward.

As the program unfolds, we will take what we learn to develop and refine it. Next year it will be open to other children and ultimately become a program that other school counselors can use wherever there's the need.


